



Brief Summary

COVID19- There are many calls this week about Coronavirus from listeners across the country. The comments reflect the diverse lifestyles and livelihoods in the country, as well as a diversity of needs and views. Here is a summary by regions:

Somaliland: many callers from the north continue to ask questions about the symptoms and spread of coronavirus; many also state that prayer is the answer. In Tukaraq, Sool, one caller says that anyone who coughs is now singled out and he urges people not to panic or to stigmatise people for simply coughing. Callers in Togdher demand the closure of all borders. Some say that now it is raining and the grass and food crops are growing, the government should ban the supply trucks bringing food and fresh produce from southern Somalia, because they travel through Ethiopia and into Somaliland risking contagion. Others, however, in the same region are complaining that prices have risen due to the pandemic. Callers from rural areas say they can no longer afford to buy rice and sugar at current prices. Another caller in Togdher complains about the garbage trucks dumping waste near the city and calls for improved standards of disposal.

Central Somalia: callers from Mudug say that prayer is part of the answer but that people must also take precautions against coronavirus. There is concern that the rains have come and the muddy conditions causing poor sanitation could favour the spread of the virus. Others callers welcome the arrival of the rains and say people are coming together to pray, which will help against coronavirus. In Galgadud, callers say all entry and exit points need to be closed as a containment measure. Some continue to ask for more awareness from Ergo, including information on medicines used in CV19 treatment. One caller asks questions about his sick sister's symptoms, including stomach ache, headache and fever, asking if it could be coronavirus. In Adado, callers urge the public to volunteer to join in the ongoing clean-up and sanitization programmes. Callers in Galgadud speak variously of price rises causing hardship; businesses being hit and people fearing to eat in restaurants; rainfall being a blessing tempered by fear of the virus; faith in god being the answer; and the ban on planes being a blight to the economy. Some communities are complaining that they are getting too much information that does not help: callers in Biyo-Gadud say the telecoms companies are causing panic by their constant talk about coronavirus, and they are threatening to throw away their Sim cards. Callers in Qalanqale similarly say that Hormuud's voice messages are causing more worry and concern especially among rural communities. A caller from central regions complains that the fish markets are highly unsanitary and need cleaning up, a comment perhaps relating to the coronavirus.

Southern regions: In Hiran, callers complain of rising food prices, poor trade, and the lack of the Somali shilling exacerbating problems at this time. Other callers urge compliance with government advice, which aligns with the Muslim duty to keep clean. Another caller urges health centres to play their part in preventing the spread of the virus. In Jalalaqsi, a caller complains that radios are causing more fear and panic by their coverage, which is leading to tensions. Callers in Middle Shabelle say they need the mosques to stay open at this time, and are surprised the koranic schools are being closed. A female caller asks if someone who has had Covid19 can catch it again. There are calls asking for more information and awareness, including one saying that he has a cough and wants to know if the virus can only come from outside. In Lower Shabelle (Warsheikh), callers celebrate rainfall but worry that khat is still coming in, some of it by boat. Callers in Gedo also say while the rain means the vegetation is now growing, but worry over coronavirus overshadows everything. A caller from Banadir urges following the prescribed precautions to stay safe.

Khat debate – this week, like last, many callers continue to demand the banning of khat. Underlying this discussion, whilst not always specifically stated in the callers’ comments, appears to be the concern over coronavirus pandemic. The callers on the topic this week are from Togdher, Mudug, Galgadud, Hiran and L. Shabelle. Overall, they are asking for all khat to be banned, especially as it is still sneaking in from Ethiopia. Callers in Hiran describe tens of sacks arriving daily despite the border closure. People call on federal and regional governments to act together. Callers say khat poses health as well as wider social risks, and it is causing people to get together in groups to chew.

Livestock – pastoralists have been calling this week with reports of mainly goat diseases, and are asking for veterinary assistance. The callers are from Somaliland, Central regions, Hiran, M. Shabelle and Gedo. Some say their animals have CCPP disease, others that the illnesses are unknown. Some report respiratory ailments, others ask about swollen milk glands. A caller from Hiran asks if the animals can get swollen glands because they are using glass or plastic instead of traditional containers for milking. A herder in Gedo says many goats have died and they need access to treatment.

Locusts – Several callers report the return of devastating locusts in Togdher, Mudug, Galgadud, Hiran. Some note that it is the planting season and they have already suffered losses from the last locust plagues.

Floods – IDP callers in Beletweyn in Hiran called to say their homes were destroyed by heavy rains and they need shelter and food. Others in Beletweyn call for repair of the river banks to prevent river flooding.

Water shortage – callers report suffering water scarcity in Sool (Hudun), Galgadud, M. Shabelle, and Qansadhere in Bay region. Some complain of lack of other services too, notably health. In Galgadud the callers said they need wells constructed, and solar power for water pumps. A caller in M. Shabelle commented that the construction of dams in Ethiopia must be causing low river levels for their community, and they ask for irrigation canals to be dug.

Rainfall – many callers have shared the arrival of the seasonal rains by calling Radio Ergo. The areas include the north, central regions, Hiran and Bay. Some are celebrating life getting better and the livestock improving, with farmers starting planting. However, some callers point out the health needs of the vulnerable that are exacerbated in the rainy season, and the lack of seeds and farming inputs. Others report migratory movements as herders move to the rainy areas for grazing and water.

Conflict – there are a number of calls this week reporting concerns around the conflict in Lower Juba, including displacements of people.
