



Brief Summary

Covid19 -This week's messages (from 16th-21st April) show that Coronavirus, either in itself, or in relation to its effects on aspects of daily life and to other stresses like localized flooding and food shortages, is the uppermost concern for most listeners across the country. To the extent that overall trends are discernible, this batch of feedback indicates fairly widespread understanding of the various measures in place to contain the spread of Covid19 (with some exceptions). There are at the same time requests for further facilities such as testing and treatment centres in rural areas and better enforcement of border closures, as well as demands for attention to the impact on rising food prices and loss of jobs. There are some complaints about mosque and Koranic school closures during Ramadan. With flu and other rainy season diseases now occurring, including malaria and diarrhoea, some callers emphasise heightened needs for increased health responses. They also ask how flu can be distinguished from Covid19, and for deeper explanation around some of the prevention advice, indicating the need for more contextualised explanations to be shared. Many people are saying that the virus is causing fear, worry, and confusion, illustrating the growing psychological strain of the pandemic on already stressed communities. The callers' comments from different regions can be summarized as follows:

Somaliland- many callers complain about uncontrolled borders allowing in consignments of khat, as well as people from neighbouring Djibouti. Several reiterate the need to ban the khat trade as well as for police to step up border controls. Several urge the following of guidelines and precautions to contain spread of the virus. Some callers note their concern around the economic downturn and fears that buying and selling of food will continue, especially in Ramadan. Some callers note that the onset of the rains is compounding vulnerability with fears of flooding. People note an upsurge in mosquitos and threat of malaria; one caller asks if mosquitos can spread Coronavirus. One caller criticises 'radios' (unspecified) for creating unnecessary fear around the virus. Several callers ask for continued updates and more details about the pandemic.

Mudug- Several callers from Mudug ask for continued detailed information about Coronavirus. Some complain about rising unemployment. The khat trade is still blamed as a source of spread of the virus among callers who want it banned. One caller says the number of those being infected is rising because some Muslims think they are exempt from the disease and are not taking precautions.

Galmudug – there are many callers applauding the precautions, or urging others to follow doctors' and government guidelines. Some are asking for testing in rural areas. A few urge prayer, and one describes the pandemic as a punishment from god. Some say mosque and Koranic school closures during Ramadan is causing hardship as the poor need alternative sources of help. Callers say prices are rising and food is becoming unaffordable and the blessing of the rains is blighted by worry and fear. One caller asks if you can catch the virus by drinking from cups that others have used.

Hiran – there are more callers from this region than others calling for prayer to alleviate the confusion brought about by Coronavirus. Some mention their fears of river flooding amid the restrictions in place. There are still concerns about the ongoing khat trade. A caller working in a pharmacy in Beletweyne asks how he can tell if the people coming in with coughs have ordinary flu or Covid19. A Caller from Mataban said his cows died because he was unable to migrate to find water due to the restrictions in place.

Banadir, M. Shabelle, L. Shabelle – callers urge people to follow the guidelines, and ask for constant information. Some say there is a need for prayer. Some say there is too much fear being created. One caller asks for local testing to be available. A woman in Wanleweyn asks how to distinguish Covid19 from the seasonal flu. She also wants to know how people can stop touching their face as advised. A caller in Balad points out that those caught breaking the curfew are asked to pay bribes.

L. Juba, Gedo – callers in Kismayo say food prices are soaring, khat is continuing to be sold, and jobs are being lost. One caller says the IDPs are desperate and need more information. Some callers from Gedo say follow the precautions, other say read the Koran. One caller wants the telecom messages to be stopped. IDPs in Bardera called to say they are living in fear of the disease and they need aid.

Floods – callers in Hiran and some parts of the south are reporting floods and fear of flooding.

Disease - callers note the onset of malaria and diarrhoea and ask for help and information.

IDPs – there are many callers this week from IDP camps notably in Galgadud, and one in Kismayo, appealing for help with shelter and basic needs in the rain.

Conflict displaced – callers from Wanleweyn in Lower Shabelle say they are returning home after being displaced by conflict. One woman described their plight with rising prices of basic food stuffs.

Livestock – herders in northern, central and Hiran regions shared a variety of symptoms affecting their animals. Many are calling in response to Ergo’s Radio Vet programme and are asking for information and expert advice.

Water – many callers from across the regions shared the welcome arrival of rainfall in their areas, whilst others in Sool and Galgadud say they are still suffering water shortages. Locusts have been reported from Somaliland and Galgadud.
