



Brief Summary

The topics of most concern to Radio Ergo listeners over the past week (28 April to 5 May 2020) were Floods and Locusts, with Coronavirus in the background. The calls that directly or indirectly mentioned COVID19 were fewer in number, with several asking questions about the disease, but the majority sharing opinions and commenting in relation to other topical issues affecting lives and livelihoods. The following summarises this crop of feedback from our independent platform:

Floods – the largest number of calls were about floods and the damage caused in various parts of the country by either heavy rain-induced flash flooding, or river flooding. Most calls came from Hiran and M. Shabelle, where some people have already been, and others fear being, affected by river floods. Other calls came from Sool, Nugal, Bari, Mudug, L. Juba, Gedo, and Bay regions. People reported the loss of homes, property, farms and crops, livestock, and livelihoods, as well as the threats of disease outbreaks. From Hiran, callers spoke of the imminent threat of the river Shabelle overflowing. Complaints about the lack of preventive measures and the recurrent cycles of floods in these areas were common. Some callers listed the types of the crops and vegetables they had lost; some said their farms had been wiped out last season and they could not withstand another round of destruction. IDP communities said they were suffering effects of torrential rain without shelter or aid. A caller in Baidoa commented that aid would be delivered and get stolen as usual and that a different approach was needed.

Locusts - a large number of callers reported the invasion of locusts affecting farms and grazing areas. The calls came from Awdal and Togdher in the north, with the majority from Galgadud in central Somalia, most notably Abudwak followed by Adado. One herding community said the grass that had just grown after three days of rainfall had been destroyed by the locusts. Callers said they had tried all known methods to ward the insects away from their farms but to no avail. Some callers had questions or asked for expert advice. (Note: Radio Ergo is launching a new series of programmes including locust experts from FAO and relevant government ministries).

COVID19 – callers from some rural parts of Somaliland and rural parts of central Somalia regions wanted to know how such communities could prevent the arrival and spread of Coronavirus, where government was not present. This has been a common theme indicating not a lack of awareness or understanding, but a desire for practical solutions. Somaliland callers urged the community to practise social distancing, expressed fear of the virus coming to their area, and thanked the radio for the information and feedback opportunity. Callers from Galmudug wanted to know how to handle the virus locally; some expressed concern for IDPs where aid services had stopped; some urged people to follow the guidelines. Some callers from central regions had questions about the duration of quarantine, how to recognize signs of recovery, and other aspects of the disease, which support the continued need for programmes such as Ergo’s CV19 Radio Doctor segments. From Mogadishu, a truck driver wanted to know how to recognize CV19 among the coughing passengers he was dropping along the route to Afgoye. From Dhobley in Gedo, a caller said he was being criticised by others for ‘staying away’ as the community did not like social distancing. From Kismayo, we had many callers this week, with some saying food prices had escalated due to the pandemic; IDPs and returnees saying they were left destitute; and youth (returnees) complaining of no jobs. Callers from the north and Galgadud continued to say that khat was coming into their areas and should be properly controlled. A woman from Galkayo, however, noted that many single mothers made a living from selling khat and needed alternative sources of income to survive.

Food security – this theme came out strongly in the week’s batch of calls, with people from different communities in Togdher, Kismayo (L. Juba), Wanleweyn (L. Shabelle) and Ba’adey (M. Shabelle) talking specifically about lack of food or fears of inadequate supplies. The theme of food security was also implicit in many of the calls on locusts and floods.

Livestock & Health – herders in Sanag and Togdher wanted advice on respiratory disease affecting their camels; some callers in Galgadud, Hiran, M. Shabelle and Bay reported illnesses in goats and wanted advice from the veterinary experts. It would seem that Ergo’s Radio Vet service is useful. A caller in Gideys, Galgadud, also requested **Measles vaccination** for their children, saying their community had not received vaccination services for a long time.
