



## Brief Summary

The largest number of calls during the week 6-12 May 2020 are reports from farmers and livestock herders about the invasion of new waves of locusts destroying crops and grazing areas. The calls came especially from Somaliland and Galmudug region. The second most common theme among the week's calls is the devastation caused by floods, most predominantly in Hiran, Middle Shabelle and Gedo regions, with a few from the north. Third in volume are the calls about Coronavirus. Many of these come from areas like Sool and Sanag and other rural parts of the country, where people are perhaps now realising that their lives could be affected. Others are from callers experiencing a range of challenges including floods, price rises, and loss of livelihood. There remains a continuous flow of specific questions relating to the virus and its symptoms, and how people can protect themselves within their own particular contextual environment. The following summarises the calls:

**COVID19 – Somaliland:** various callers in Sanag asked how rural people can identify the virus and how they can protect themselves and others given their rural location. A caller in Sool said nobody has changed their behaviour yet and life is going on as normal. People are still concerned about the khat trade going on in these areas. A caller in coastal Lasqoray was concerned about the continuing influx of Ethiopian migrants trying to cross to Yemen and wanted their movement to be restricted. A caller in Togdher spoke of rising local unemployment due to the pandemic.

**Puntland:** truck drivers say their livelihoods have been affected by the CV19 slowdown. A caller in Bosaso complained of continued overcrowding on buses and lack of government controls. In Qardho, callers said people are running away in fear from the sick. In Garowe, a caller said despite Puntland government declaring 13 new cases he did not believe the disease was real.

**Central regions:** callers in Mudug said Coronavirus was still a major talking point. Some called for stricter adherence to physical distancing measures. A female (presumed to be a student) in Galkayo said they were still attending school wearing home clothes to avoid being noticed. Callers welcomed the rain but feared muddy conditions would exacerbate poor hygiene and sanitation. **Southern regions:** A caller in flood-hit Beledweyne decried the lack of testing facilities for diseases generally; some in M. and L. Shabelle asked questions about the distinction between CV19 and the flu, and the vulnerability of already sick people. In Baidoa, IDP callers wanted the curfew to be lifted, and another caller was concerned about reaching those in remote rural areas with awareness. A caller in Kismayo wanted the CV19 flight ban lifted in order to respond to the flood crises. (NB. Radio Ergo follows up some calls journalistically for reporting, and may include others in its editorial planning around Radio Doctor, Radio Sheikh, and Radio Drama content segments on CV19).

**Locusts** – many callers reported the devastation of farms and livestock fodder, most notably in Somaliland (Hargeisa, Sanag, Sool, Togdher), and all across Galgadud, with one call from Bay region. They graphically described their losses. The callers asked for government and other organisations to help with control measures. (NB. Radio Ergo is launching this week a new series of informative programmes on locusts with FAO experts, including response to listeners' questions).

**Floods** – the majority of flood callers came from Hiran, M. Shabelle and Gedo, with some from affected areas of Puntland. In Beledweyn callers decried the lack of preventive action since the last 2019 flood disaster. People said they are being displaced, with some displaced to Bananey in urgent need of fresh water. Farmers in Mahadey (M. Shabelle) said they were blighted by floods, locusts and other hardships and needed support and investment.

A farmers' leader in Sakow (M. Shabelle) said their assets were wiped out. In Bardera (Gedo), a small farmers' cooperative said they had lost all their crops, generators and investment and could not repay their debts.

**Livestock** – pastoralists reported sick camels and goats and rainy season diseases in northern and central regions and largely addressed their questions to our Radio Vet experts.
