



Brief Summary

The messages included in this report were recorded by callers to the Radio Ergo platform between 26-31 May 2020. The three most common issues being talked about were the spread of Coronavirus, the invasion of locusts, and the effects of floods. As well as the impact of these main issues on people's livelihoods, there were also a significant number of messages relating specifically to livelihoods, notably farming, livestock, and IDP jobs. The following provides a short summary by theme.

Coronavirus- callers from different regions reported cases of sickness in their areas that they assumed to be Covid19, in the absence of confirmation through testing. Some callers from Berbera noted many people losing their sense of taste and smell and asked for diagnostic facilities to be set up as well as access to more information. There were many calls from Galmudug, notably from Adado, where callers expressed concerns over the large numbers of infections discovered in the district. They complained about the lack of testing facilities and equipment such as ventilators. Some callers said the virus was now widespread and had infected the pastoralist communities. Callers in Hiran had several questions about the virus and how to recognize it, indicating a possible proximity to suspected cases. Callers in Sanag said they needed medical staff and facilities to help in the rural areas. There were also several calls from livestock herders in this region saying their camels were sick with symptoms that made them think it was Coronavirus. In Sool, some callers complained about the economic downturn resulting from the pandemic and said there were food shortages. A large number of callers from different regions reiterated the need for taking precautions such as handwashing and physical distancing and following the guidelines of the authorities and experts. Some called for prayer. A female caller in Mudug said Coronavirus was just like the flu so people should stop panicking. A caller in Beletweyne advised that Covid19 patients needed to be well cared for with nutritious food. A caller in Baidoa said there were other diseases like diarrhoea and measles that killed many people and that the Coronavirus lockdown had destroyed jobs and livelihoods for most of the IDPs. There were still some questions addressed to the radio doctors about symptoms and effective prevention methods.

Floods- the majority of calls about floods came from Hiran, especially Beletweyn. Callers described many deaths and loss of farms, property and livestock caused by the flooding of the river Shabelle. Some said that the authorities acted too late and a sustainable solution to cycles of flooding was urgently needed. Displaced people talked of their fears of diseases spreading and their need for aid. One displaced female caller said there were many cases of Covid19 among them because of crowding in displacement sites at El-Jalle. Other callers complained of losing their farms and livelihoods in Gedo (Bardera and Burdhubo) and M. Juba.

Locusts- a large number of calls about locusts were received again from northern and central regions. The majority of calls came from Togdher, Sool, Sanag, Mudug, Galgadud, and Hiran. Some said the measures they had tried such as smoking the locusts out had failed. Most called for organized control measures to be brought to their areas. Some farmers asked if the locusts would leave long-lasting effects on the soil that could affect future planting seasons.

Agriculture- there were a large number of calls from farmers, asking questions to the experts used in Ergo's weekly farming programme. Most were reporting problems with crop pests. Most callers were from Sanag, Puntland, Galgadud, Hiran, L. Shabelle, and Jubaland.

Livestock- there were many calls from livestock owners describing diseases affecting goats and camels, especially in northern regions Sool and Sanag. Callers from Kalabaydh, Badhan, and Qalanqalo all linked the sickness of their camels to Coronavirus. Other calls mainly about goats came from Galgadud, Hiran and L. Shabelle (Barawe). A caller in Ballibusle, Mudug, said action needed to be taken to protect the grazing land following an influx of livestock from other areas.

Aid and IDPs- some communities in Puntland (Nugal) complained they were being registered and having photos taken by groups who did not come back to deliver any aid. Some displaced former pastoralists also in Puntland reported that they were being evicted from their camps by those who wanted to fence off the land for grazing after the rainfall.
