



Brief Summary

The calls received from listeners across the country during the week 7-13 June 2020 show a preoccupation with livelihoods being at risk from combined threats (depending on locations) of locusts; Coronavirus and secondary impacts on job losses; floods; livestock diseases; and emerging water shortages. The following summarises the calls by theme.

Coronavirus- callers expressed a general concern over inadequate measures to stem the spread of the virus, such as lack of testing facilities, as well as demands for support for jobs and basic services like water and education. Several callers from Togdher in the north complained that the threat of the virus was real, yet khat was still coming into the country and people were not taking precautions. One caller asked how far people should stay apart for distancing. Callers from Bari also complained about the khat trade continuing despite the spread of the virus. A caller from Galkayo said there were unreported COVID19 cases and the government needed to act. Another called for enforcement of the ban on khat. IDPs in Salama camp in Galmudug said there were Coronavirus cases in the camp and they had no water. A caller in Galgadud talked of unemployment resulting from the pandemic and urged the government to help. Callers from Beletweyn, Hiran, said there was need to contain the spread of infections there, with a female caller reporting deaths and demanding testing facilities. In Kismayo, a female caller complained that people were crowding in public spaces and transport and there were no face masks. Another caller said he was disseminating awareness information from Radio Ergo to convince people to take the virus seriously. Several callers from Bardera, Gedo, complained about the lack of government services generally and the lack of testing facilities and face masks. A female in Bardera called for the reopening of schools. A female caller from an unspecified location said her farm had been destroyed by floods and now her small shop business had collapsed due to the Coronavirus economic downturn.

Locusts- the highest number of calls this week were about the damage suffered by pastoralist and farming communities by locusts. Calls came from across Somaliland and Puntland, as well as central Somalia and Hiran. People described waves of locusts leaving larvae behind. Most callers complained of the loss of pasture for their livestock and destruction of crops and wanted intervention by governmental authorities and aid organisations. A caller in Mudug said they had lost all their food crops and now needed food aid. Some said their livestock were being scared away, others that water sources had been completely taken over by locusts. A caller from Abudwak, Galgadud, said his community of 100 families needed urgent access to pesticides. A female IDP in Adado, Galgadud, said they were beset by twin challenges of locusts and malaria.

Floods- several callers from Hiran and M. Shabelle complained about not having recovered from the effects of the floods, with food shortages, malaria, and general lack of aid and services. A flood-displaced caller from Balad said they had not eaten yesterday and did not expect lunch today.

Livestock- pastoralists from Somaliland complained about camel and goat diseases, asking for advice and assistance. Callers from Puntland and central regions spoke mainly about goat disease and ticks. Herders in Abudwak wanted help in knowing how to stop foxes from attacking their livestock. A caller from Beletweyne said livestock prices had dropped substantially and listed in detail current prices of animals. Hiran callers also had complaints about goat disease. Camel disease was reported from Bardera, Gedo, with one caller wondering if the livestock were getting sick from eating locusts.

Agriculture- there was a large number of callers especially from central and southern regions asking for advice about crop pests. (Radio Ergo's farming segment has become popular, and most callers are seeking advice from the programme experts.)

Malaria- a number of callers mentioned the rise in malaria, including from Sool, Galgadud, Hiran, and M. and L. Shabelle.

Water shortage- a number of callers reported not having enough water for themselves, their farms, and livestock. Calls about water crisis came from Galmudug, Togdher, Hiran and L. Juba.

Conflict and services – a number of callers reported that conflict in parts of Togdher, Nugal, and Mudug was leaving them cut off from basic needs and services. They wanted governmental authorities to intervene.
