



Brief Summary

The calls from Radio Ergo listeners during the week 14-20 June 2020 present a combination of concerns and challenges, including: the spread of COVID19; destruction of farms and grazing by locusts; food insecurity with rising food prices and falling livestock prices; water shortage; and disruption and vulnerability due to conflict. The following summarises the calls received by themes.

Coronavirus- the most common question raised by this week's callers was how to differentiate between COVID19 and the common flu. These calls came from Hargeisa, Bosaso, Garowe, Beletweyn and other places in Hiran, and Bay. It is reasonable to assume from the calls that people are reacting to cases of sickness that they are seeing around them and wanting to know more. Callers also asked whether vomiting is a symptom of CV19; if CV19 can be confused with malaria; and if you can get CV19 as badly a second time. One female caller from Bosaso asserted that Muslims do not believe in Coronavirus and what they are seeing is flu. Another female caller from Galgadud warned on the contrary that the virus does not discriminate based on faith. There was concern about the ability of communities to prevent the virus spreading. Several callers in Adado said there were many cases there, the government needed to intervene, and people should stay at home for 14 days if sick. A caller in Ainabo, Togdher, said the virus was widespread and people should keep their distance. In Beletweyn, a caller said the market women needed to use face coverings. In Balanbal, Galgadud, a caller said rural people were unable to protect themselves as they lacked water. A caller in Balli-dhig, Togdher, said youth from the health ministry were conducting door-to-door awareness and had not encountered any cases. There were concerns expressed over the secondary impact of the virus. A female in Bosaso called for the reopening of education centres so students could sit their exams. A caller in Dusamareb, Galgadud, said they had been pushed into poverty by losing access to casual work during the pandemic.

Floods impact- there were a number of callers from Hiran, especially Beletweyn, complaining about the repeated destruction of houses and toilets by flooding, and asking for long-term solutions. Callers said their problems were being exacerbated by conflict on the Elbur side of Hiran. People in El-Jalle said they had no access to clean water. In Jalalaqsi, callers said that malaria was on the rise after the floods. In Lower Shabelle, callers from Kuntawarey and Bula-Marer said they had been neglected for nine months, and had no water and no aid. Callers in Kamkam, L. Juba, appealed for help after their farms were flooded. A caller in Bardera, Gedo, said they were stranded and destitute with their children after flooding in the area.

Food security- there were a number of callers complaining about food shortages, as well as water scarcity in their areas. These calls came from Sool, Puntland, Mudug, Mogadishu, and M. Shabelle. Some appear to be IDPs, although they did not always name themselves as such, and said they are destitute. Some callers spoke of aid diversion in Hiran and Gedo and asked Ergo to investigate.

Locusts- the largest number of calls on a single topic in this week's report was about the problems being caused by locusts, affecting pastoralists and farmers. The calls came from across Somaliland, Puntland, central Somali regions, Hiran, with a smaller number from M. and L.Shabelle. The people described waves of locusts and hopper bands. They asked for access to pesticides and control measures. (Radio Ergo is running an ongoing weekly series with FAO experts addressing questions on locusts and some callers are no doubt responding to the programmes).

Livestock- pastoralists in Togdher, Sool and Sanag called with complaints about livestock diseases and deaths of camels. One caller listed camel prices as having dropped from three to one million shillings. These callers also reported human health issues and lack of basic services in their areas. A caller from Abudwak, Galgadud, reported livestock and human health issues, lack of water, and general economic hardship.

Conflict- there was a notable number of callers about conflict and the impact on people's lives. These came mostly from Hiran. A female caller in Beletweyn said innocent farmers and pastoralists were being killed in clan clashes. Farmers in Hiran also reported being attacked by Liyuu forces from Ethiopia. A female caller from Balad, M. Shabelle, said the ongoing conflict there had become unbearable. Callers also reported deaths from conflict ongoing in Wanlewyn, L. Shabelle.
