



Brief Summary

Most calls by far on Radio Ergo's independent platform this week (6-11 October 2020) were about the plagues of desert locusts affecting most northern regions, with new invasions reported in Galgadud, Hiran, M. Shabelle and elsewhere. Callers remained concerned by Coronavirus with questions about symptoms and diagnosis mainly from Puntland and southern regions. There were also calls about water scarcity and rising food prices in various parts of the country. The following summarises the week's calls by theme.

Locusts – the calls about locusts came from across the northern regions with the most appearing to be from Nugal. A caller in Garowe said helicopters had flown over trying to chase the locusts away but they needed pesticides. In central Somalia, callers complained about the locust invasions in Adado, Abudwak, Dusamareb, Biyo-Gadud, and Hilmo. A caller in Dusamareb said they could not see the clouds through the thick swarms and the locusts had contaminated the little water they had caught from recent rainfall. A female caller in Abudwak said they had tried to spray the locusts but some people in the community were against this. In Middle Shabelle, a caller in Mahaday said the locusts descended on 8 October and were eating their sesame crops. A caller in Elasha-Biyaha, L.Shabelle, said the locusts arrived on 6 October when rainfall began in the area.

Coronavirus – this week's calls were mainly directed to the Radio Doctor (regular segments on Radio Ergo), asking questions about symptoms experienced by the caller or a close relative. Such calls came from Galkayo, Guriel, Hiran, Jowhar, Bardera and Luq. Several callers said they knew about the virus but wanted to know how to protect themselves in rural areas lacking in facilities. There were questions about distinguishing Coronavirus from flu; whether remedies from the Neem tree or any special foods could help; and second time infections. A caller in Garowe asked how the US president had recovered if there was no cure. A female caller in Jowhar complained about people neglecting all precautions against the virus. A caller in Baidoa asked if the virus had gone and it was safe to return to life as normal.

Water scarcity – there were calls about lack of water from parts of Togdher, Sanag, Galgadud, M. Shabelle and Gedo. A community in Libah-sehay, Abudwak, complained that resources especially water were not being fairly distributed among clans and this was creating tensions.

IDPs – callers from IDP camps in Bardera and Dollow in Gedo complained of water scarcity as well as the lack of other basic services.

Livelihood issues – callers in Galkayo and IDPs in Puntland complained about rising prices. Some callers hit by the Shabelle river floods were still suffering the consequences of their losses. On the other hand, callers described improving conditions in areas where there had been rainfall. A female caller in Adado said they were recovering and their livestock were producing a lot of milk.
