



Brief Summary

Once again locusts were the major subject of concern this week (19-25 November 2020) according to the number of calls to Radio Ergo's independent audience feedback platform. Locust calls came predominantly from central regions, with others from northern and some southern parts as well. Many locust callers articulated related challenges including water shortages, or floods, and stressed livelihoods. There were calls from northern areas hit by cyclone Gati. A number of communities called about water scarcity in northern regions and also Gedo in the southwest. Concerns about Coronavirus continued to generate calls especially questions about symptoms. (Note that Radio Ergo's newsroom selectively follows up some calls for reporting purposes, whilst others are used in our thematic programme segments.) The following summarises this week's calls by theme.

Locusts – calls this week came from communities in Awdal, Togdher, Sanag and Sool, Bari, Nugal, and Mudug. The biggest numbers were from Galmudug especially Adado and Abudwak; with significant numbers from Middle and Lower Shabelle, and also Hiran. Some callers faced multiple challenges, such as one identifying as an IDP in Gumeys, Somaliland, who said they were battling locusts and water shortage. In Qardho, a caller said the Puntland government had sprayed once but the locusts were back and needed spraying again. Callers in central Somalia spoke of a shortage of fresh food and looming desertification. In Abudwak, a caller said the locusts had entered their houses and even got in their beds. In Adado, a caller said the locusts stopped people from sitting outside at tea shops and had affected other businesses too. Several callers said the locusts had covered and contaminated their water sources. A caller in Afgoye said they faced water shortage as well as locusts, whilst a caller in Qoryooley, also in L. Shabelle, and others in M. Shabelle said their farms were threatened by locusts and flooding. A female nomadic pastoralist calling from a location in central Somalia said their animals lacked fodder and water and they had no livestock to sell to earn income. A handful of callers were concerned about the possible harm caused by pesticides to animals, or warned not to kill god's creatures. (Radio Ergo has been airing a special weekly locust programme since May with reports, information, and experts' answers to listeners' questions).

COVID19 – there were calls from Somaliland, Puntland, and central regions, mostly describing Coronavirus-like symptoms the caller was experience and/or observed in the local community. Most asked for diagnosis and advice. A caller in Somaliland said people didn't want to talk about the widespread disease. In Galgadud, a caller said coughing and flu-like symptoms were widespread. A caller in an unidentified location wanted to know about the efficacy of face masks in blocking aerosol particles from a sneeze. (Radio Ergo continues its weekly broadcasts with WHO doctor answering listeners' questions on COVID19).

Water shortage – calls about lack of water came from parts of Somaliland, Puntland, and also Gedo. Callers from Buhodle, Togdher, asked for water aid, including some who said they had been displaced from Ayn. Callers in Sanag and Sool spoke of a tripling in prices of water. A disabled pastoralist calling from Ainabo, in Somaliland's northern Sool region, said he was unable to migrate in search of water and their livestock were failing to sell. In Gedo, callers said the rains had failed and there was drought.

Extreme weather - Ergo received some calls from people caught up in the effects of the cyclone that hit northeastern regions. Elsewhere, people in areas near the Shabelle river complained of being hit by flooding, including refugees returned from Kenya and now farming in Warsheikh, M. Shabelle.
