



Brief Summary

Callers this week (2-8 December 2020) to Radio Ergo's independent feedback platform were mostly concerned about the worsening invasions of locusts across many parts of the country. The biggest number of calls came from Galmudug, with other significant numbers from Sanag in the north, and Hiran and Middle Shabelle in the south. Callers in Puntland and Mudug were concerned about rising costs of food and the inability to spend shillings. Callers reported drought conditions in Togdher, Hiran, and Gedo. There were several calls to the Radio Doctor about COVID19 symptoms. The following summarises the calls by theme.

Locusts – callers in Salahley, south of Hargeisa, said they had been invaded by locusts in recent days. In Burao callers also reported new swarms, with one describing it as a test from god. A caller in Balli-dhig (Togdher) said it was one of the first areas to be hit by locusts months ago and the larvae were still there. A large number of people called from Sanag this week, mostly saying locusts had been destroying the grazing and crops. In Sool, a caller in Kalabaydh said the valley had been invaded for the fifth time by locusts, and with the recently grown pasture now destroyed they were heading for drought. New waves were reported in parts of Nugal and Mudug. A female caller in Galkayo said she had been planting trees on her land and woke up to find them all stripped of leaves. People in Abudwak and Adado spoke of huge numbers of locusts invading. Many were worried about the state of their livestock without fodder. One of the many callers in Adado said the locust swarms had blocked out the sunlight for seven hours. He called for allied countries such as UAE and Turkey to come and help Somalia control the locusts. A caller in Dawdawle, Galgadud, said three weeks after the invading locusts had left the area, their larvae had grown causing fresh problems. They called for aerial spraying. This week there were many callers from Hiran. In Beletweyn callers said the locusts were eating vegetation, food and even clothing. The farmers had invested time and money in planting again after the losses in recent floods and now they faced devastation again and needed help. Communities in Mahas said they were trying all measures to ward off the locusts, including smoke and gunshots. People in Jowhar, M. Shabelle, were also worried about their ability to survive another shock. One caller said the local farmers and pastoralists worked hard despite the lack of investment and support in the district, but drought and now locusts meant they required aid. A few callers from Bay (Baidoa and Dinsor) and Gedo (Bardera and El-Wak) reported fresh waves of locusts arriving in their areas.

Cash crisis – the escalating prices of basic food items caused much concern among callers from Puntland and Mudug. People in Qardho and Bosaso said currency exchange rates and rejection of the shilling were leading to poverty. In Bosaso there were also problems with locusts. Those hit by cyclone Gati in Hafun were also suffering from price rises. A female caller in Puntland said Golis mobile app now allowed for transfer of minimum 25 cents. Callers in Galkayo complained of price rises and inability to spend shillings locally.

Drought and water shortage – callers in Togdher and Hiran spoke of drought and water scarcity with high costs of water on sale. A female IDP caller in Dollow, Gedo, said they lacked water and food. Farmers in Bardera, Gedo, said there was drought after failed rains and sorghum crops were affected.

COVID19 – there were several calls asking questions to the Radio Doctors mainly about symptoms. (Radio Ergo is continuing weekly segments with WHO experts responding to listeners' questions).
