Brief Summary			
The calls recorded on Radio Ergo’s nationwide audience feedback platform in the week 30 July to 5 August 2026 give a glimpse into the differing fortunes of various livelihood groups across different regions of the country. For example, there were reports of good farm harvests from some southern locations alongside complaints of water shortage, food insecurity and general hardship. Rainfall was cited by callers mainly from southern regions, whilst a few spoke of localised river floods, and others mentioned continuing drought and livestock losses. Most calls about drought and its impact came from northern and central parts. Many callers in northern areas said they only had access currently to salty or brackish water. Central region callers noted the seasonal windy conditions and their hopes for the next rainy season. The following summarises the calls by theme. Floods – a caller in Jowhar, Middle Shabelle region, complained that the river had been constantly overflowing and inundating farms whenever they started planting their crops. Farmers wanted assistance in protecting their farms. A female caller in Jamame, Lower Juba, said they were also concerned about constant river floods. She wanted aid organisations to help them get boats, plastic shelters and other essentials. IDPs & Aid – a caller in Goob-weyn, Lower Juba, said he was among IDPs living in camps for the past six years. He claimed that they were registered by some aid organisations that had not delivered any aid, which instead was given instead to traders or other people in towns. He wanted Radio Ergo to share their message to ensure justice in aid delivery. A caller in Dollow, Gedo region, said IDP families were facing hardships due to rising prices making it harder to make a living. He added an appeal for help. Food Security – a caller in Baidoa, Bay region, said farmers had had a good harvest and were doing well whilst preparing the land for the next season. Another in Baidoa said there was high unemployment and the youth needed jobs. A caller in Bardera, Gedo, said farmers were harvesting and doing well. A caller in Huriway village [Banadir?] said farmers there had a bumper harvest of watermelons, tomatoes, gourds and other vegetables, and wanted traders to contact them for sales. A caller in Qoryolley, Lower Shabelle region, complained that the rejection by traders of the Somali shilling had affected local people’s lives and they needed the government to restore the currency. Health – a caller in Bardera, Gedo, said they needed treatment advice for cases of chikungunya disease being reported in the area. Nutrition - in Jowhar, a breast-feeding mother living in Suuqa-xoolaha, said she didn’t know where she could get nutrition supplements and wanted to know the nearest places for access. Another female caller in Wanlaweyn, Lower Shabelle, said she and her daughter were both malnourished. Her baby did not breastfeed and she wanted to know where she could get nutrition supplements. [Radio Ergo airs public announcement encouraging people to take patients with symptoms of malnutrition to the nearest centres for treatment and supplements. It would be helpful to be able to provide more information to listeners about which centres are open and their precise locations.] Climate – a caller in Adado, Galgadud region, said they were facing strong winds that were destroying farmers’ crops and houses. He appealed for help. Others in Galgadud also cited strong winds, hoping the weather augured the arrival or rain.			

Livestock – among callers to the Radio Vet programme, herders in Landher and Bangeele had problems with their goats and sheep respectively licking or eating sand and wanted to know the cause. Callers in various central and southern locations cited goat diseases including foot and mouth, describing symptoms of diarrhoea, coughing, fever and runny noses. A caller in Guriel wanted help with his goats that were miscarrying in their fourth month. A listener in Barawe, Lower Shabelle, complained that the veterinary experts responding to questions on the radio were using English instead of Somali terms. He thought they could be young university graduates educated in English. He said the experts should consult with local people to ensure they used the correct language when speaking to the rural audience who don't read or write. A caller in Dollow, Ethiopia's Somali Region, wanted to know what caused the discrepancies in **livestock market prices** across the region.

Rainfall – the regions producing the most calls about rainfall this week were Middle Shabelle and Lower Juba.

Drought and water shortage – a caller in Berbera said people and livestock were suffering from drought and water shortage, with the only available water being salty. He called on Somaliland authorities to help them. Several in Togdher region said they'd had little rain and water was short. One caller said they had been displaced from Galgaduud region to Togdher due to drought, but they continued to face hardship with their livestock. A caller in Geeri, Sahil, said they only had salty water and needed government help. A female caller in Dayah, Sanag region, said they faced food and water shortage. In Mudug, a female caller in Galkayo appealed for aid due to drought and water shortage, saying the wells produced brackish water. Among many callers across Galgaduud, two in Abudwak said their livestock were dying. A female caller in Hananbure wanted help from government and aid groups as their livestock were failing. Another in Herale also said their livestock were dying and they needed aid. A caller in Mataban, Hiran, said the drought had stretched for more than four years. Callers in Balad in M. Shabelle and Qurdubey in Bay said livestock were dying. In Gedo, a female caller in Bardera appealed for aid, and two in Beledhawo said the last rains had been poor and they were back to water shortages. A caller in Burdhubo said farmers had not managed to plant their crops due to inadequate rainfall.
